Strategic Planning Committee – This committee has not met

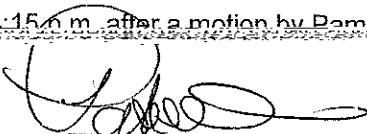
#### IV. NEW BUSINESS
